

Turning the Error Off

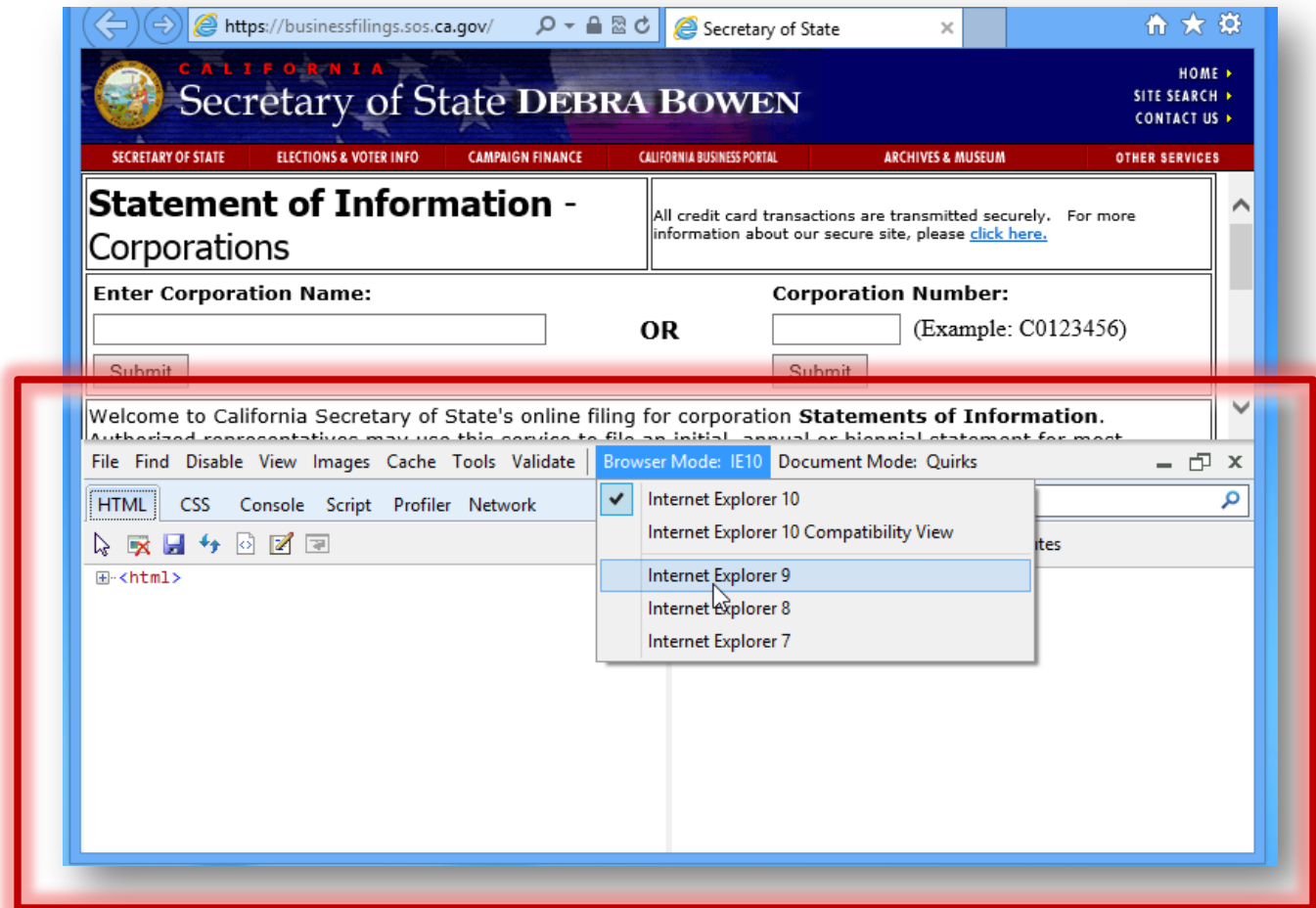
To turn this error off, click the gear icon  located at the top/right corner of your browser, then select **F12 Developer Tools**. (Or use the shortcut by pressing F12.)
